Biography or History

Edmundo Ricardo Delgado (1932-1995), an important political figure in the state, was not only a member of the New Mexico House of Representatives, State Senator, and successful businessman, but also a historian who made significant contributions to the Hispanic history of New Mexico. As an independent historian Delgado published numerous articles in English and Spanish languages including feature articles in local, regional, and national newspapers and magazines. He also taught genealogy classes at the University of New Mexico Continuing Education and the College of Santa Fe and gave lectures and seminar papers at various symposia and conferences.

In 1996, his family donated to the National Hispanic Cultural Center approximately 43 cubic feet of document, photograph and film collections. A significant portion of the collection consists of genealogical research on New Mexican families, in particular the Delgado and Espinosa lineages. In addition, the collection also consists of over 200 books which have been placed in the library, archival information on the creation of the Juan de Oñate monument, the Pecos monument and other historical sites, and numerous videos, slides and photographs dealing with New Mexican history, culture, folklore, and tourism.

Scope and Content

The Edmundo Delgado Collection includes books, published and unpublished manuscripts, newspaper articles, facsimiles of original colonial documents, original colonial and territorial documents, photos, art objects, radio broadcasts, and video documentation. With approximately 200 titles, the book collection focuses on New Mexican history and the southwest. The collection contains genealogical research on New Mexican families in particular the Delgado and Espinosa families and excellent materials on witchcraft in New Mexico produced during the WPA era. The many important examples of historical documents represent the colonial, Mexican, Territorial and Statehood periods of New Mexican history. The manuscripts contain information on historical monuments and sites and on important cultural events ranging from the Santa Fe Fiesta and the De Vargas pageantry to New Mexican cooking.
