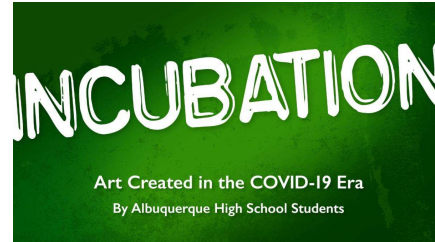

Incubation

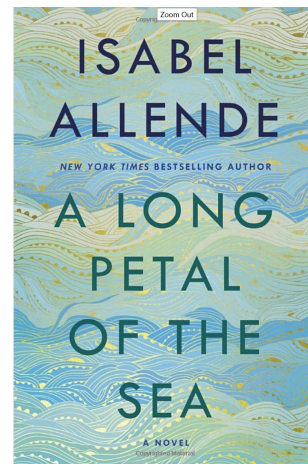
